

TB Testing & Immunity (Titers)

These tests are commonly required for employment, school enrollment, healthcare programs, and compliance documentation. They help organizations verify that individuals are free from certain communicable diseases or have immunity through vaccination or prior exposure.

WHY TB TESTING IS REQUIRED

Tuberculosis (TB) is an airborne infectious disease that can spread in workplaces, schools, and healthcare settings. TB testing is required to help identify individuals who may have been exposed to TB, even if they have no symptoms. Early identification supports public health safety and protects vulnerable populations.

TUBERCULOSIS (TB) TESTING OPTIONS

- **TB Skin Test (PPD) — \$79**
A small amount of testing solution is placed just under the skin of the arm to check for a reaction. This test requires a return visit within 48–72 hours for reading. Commonly required for employment, school, or volunteer clearance.
- **Two-Step TB Skin Test — \$139**
A two-part version of the TB skin test often required for healthcare workers or students entering clinical programs. It helps establish a reliable baseline for individuals who will be tested regularly.
- **QuantiFERON®-TB Gold Plus (Blood Test) — \$189**
A laboratory-based blood test that helps detect TB infection without the need for a return visit. Often accepted in place of skin testing for employment and school requirements.

IMMUNITY & VACCINE TITERS – WHY THEY ARE NEEDED

Immunity (titer) tests measure antibodies in the blood to determine whether a person is protected against certain diseases. These tests are commonly required when vaccination records are unavailable or when proof of immunity is needed for work or school.

- **MMR Titer — \$129**
Confirms immunity to measles, mumps, and rubella. Commonly required for healthcare, childcare, and school enrollment.
- **Measles (Rubeola) Titer — \$49**
Checks immunity to measles, a highly contagious viral illness.
- **Mumps Titer — \$49**
Evaluates immunity to mumps, which can cause swelling of the salivary glands and other complications.
- **Rubella Titer — \$49**
Screens immunity to rubella (German measles), especially important for women of childbearing age.
- **Varicella (Chickenpox) Titer — \$59**
Confirms immunity to chickenpox, often required for healthcare and school settings.

- **Hepatitis B Immunity (Surface Antibody) — \$49**
Determines immunity to hepatitis B, a bloodborne virus commonly screened for healthcare and occupational clearance.
